Board Recognition Awards:

1) Fleetwood Physical Education Teacher Carol Lynch

The Board of Education presented a Board Recognition Award to Fleetwood Physical Education Teacher Carol Lynch, who was selected as Elementary School Physical Education Teacher of the Year for the Eastern District by the National Association for Sport and Physical Education. Mrs. Lynch was selected for the honor because of her innovative programs and extensive work in promoting life-long physical fitness to students at the Fleetwood School. The Eastern District includes 11 states and the District of Columbia. Mrs. Lynch spoke to members of Congress and the President's Council on Physical Education and Sports this summer about the role of physical education in preventing childhood obesity.

2) Hartford School Fifth-Grade Teacher Jayne King

The Board of Education presented a Board Recognition Award to Hartford Math and Social Studies Teacher Jayne King, who has been selected as a finalist in the Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching. Mrs. King was one of four nominees chosen statewide who will now advance to the national competition. Two Presidential Award winners will be selected from each state next spring. Mrs. King was chosen for the nation's highest honor on the basis of her experience and the creation of meaningful math lessons for her students.
