If you are moving out of Mount Laurel, you will need to present immunization information to the school nurse at the new school. Mrs. Bosch will provide you with this information. You will also need to obtain a copy of a State of NJ Transfer Card from Mrs. Cantwell, which will then be forwarded to your child's new school. Upon receipt of this notification, the new school will then request school records from Fleetwood.

We ask that you do not wait until the last week of school to notify us as we sometimes receive many requests for transfers, and it takes some preparation to compile this information. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Please return this form to your child's teacher as soon as possible.
